ANGLING RECORDING INSTRUCTIONS

IMMEDIATELY upon catching and KEEPING a steelhead, adult chinook salmon (as defined in the Freshwater Salmon Supplement published by DFO), rainbow trout over 50 cm from Kootenay Lake or Shuswap Lake, or char over 60 cm from Shuswap Lake, record in INK the water names, region and date of capture. Refer to the angling regulations for daily quotas and size limit.
